

Enrolment Policy

1. Introduction

The McDonald College offers enrolment to students whom the College considers will benefit from our unique program and contribute positively to the College community.

2. Enrolment

- 1. Applications for enrolment may be made at any time by the parent/carer(s) of students to commence in any year from Kindergarten to Year 11 or Year 12 under special circumstances.
- 2. Students enrolling at the College for the first time will be five years of age on or before 31 July in the year of entry.
- 3. The College will base any decision about offering a place to a student on:

Family relationship with the College:

- sibling of a current or ex-student.
- either of the parents attended the College.

The student:

- Must have abilities, attitudes, values and priorities that are compatible with the performance ethos of the College.
- Students from Year 7 and beyond must audition (performing arts) and in Year 5 and beyond must attend a trial (tennis) prior to an enrolment place being offered. Students from Year 7 and beyond are required to sit an academic test prior to entry.
- The contribution that the student may make to the College, including the co-curricular activities.
- The student's reports from previous schools or prior to school service e.g. the NSW Department of Education's Transition to School Statement.



The College:

- Ability to meet the special needs or abilities of the student.
- 4. The College <u>may/will</u> meet with parent/carer(s) of the student before offering a place.
- 5. The College has an absolute discretion in determining the weight of each of the factors it takes into account in determining whether to offer a place for the student.
- 6. Continued enrolment at the College is dependent upon the student making satisfactory academic progress, attending consistently, and the student and the parent/carer(s) observing all behavioural codes of conduct and other requirements of the College which are applicable from time to time.
